

Eastrop Park Basingstoke

How to get here on foot

Eastrop Park is a 5-minute walk from Festival Place. The new Eastrop Link provides a safe pedestrian route into the park and has enhanced the park's western entrance with a 12 jet 'dry plaza' water feature.

By bicycle

There is a direct cycle route link connecting Festival Place with Eastrop Park with a single pedestrian and cyclist crossing point to provide a safe entrance into the park.


By car

From the M3 follow signs for the town centre. From Eastrop roundabout follow the signs to London Road and down Eastrop Lane. There are two small car parks with disabled parking spaces.

By bus

The park is a five minute walk from the Bus Station or the Eastrop Lane bus stop. Alternatively, the 'purple' bus from the town's park and ride service stops at City Wall House on Basing View, where the park is accessed via a short walk across the foot bridge.
